Courageous Conversations with Dr. John Carlos, a former track and field athlete and professional football player. Carlos was the bronze-medal winner in the 200 meters at the 1968 Summer Olympics and his historic "Black Power" salute on the podium with Tommie Smith resulted in political controversy. In 1985, Carlos became a counselor and in-school suspension supervisor, as well as the track and field coach, at Palm Springs High School in California. In 2003, he was elected to the National Track & Field Hall of Fame.
