On Saturday, April 1st, there will be a town hall meeting with legislators to discuss funding for all students. Legislators are making important decisions right now during the 2017 Legislative Session.

AB394 empowered parents, educators and principals at each school to create a budget designed to achieve good student outcomes.

Over, 350 Site-based Organizational Teams have met to develop their school's budget. Their experience can provide valuable insight to legislators about what type and how much funding is needed to ensure all students get the education they deserve.

Senate Bill 178, sponsored by Senator Mo Denis, addresses the need for additional funding; specifically, funding for students that have unique needs. For example, students that are English Language Learners, Gifted and Talented Education students, at risk students, and students living in poverty.

All legislators from Southern Nevada have been invited to attend. Parents, educators and administrators are invited to this special town hall meeting to speak with legislators about the issue of funding our schools. Please attend and let your voice be heard!
