Sick Leave Pool Enrollment

2020–21 Open Enrollment Begins May 1st through May 31st

In 1998, CCEA negotiated with CCSD to create the Sick Leave Pool to give educators with catastrophic illness or injury access to additional sick leave days above those they have accrued. Educators with a catastrophic illness/injury, and who have enrolled in the Sick Leave Pool, can apply to the Sick Leave Pool Committee for days once their own sick and personal leave has been used. Lifetime usage of the pool is limited to 100 days maximum per person; immediate family members are not covered under this provision.

How does the Sick Leave Pool work?

- 1) Enrollment in the Sick Leave Pool is voluntary.
- 2) The open enrollment periods are September 1-30 and May 1-31 of each school year.
- 3) Enrollment is open to any educator who has accrued six (6) days of unused sick days.
- 4) One (1) sick leave day is deducted from each educator who joins the pool.

You only need to enroll in the pool once.
