WHAT WE DO

Opportunity Village is a not-for-profit organization that serves people throughout our community with intellectual disabilities, to enhance their lives and the lives of the families who love them.

Opportunity Village is dedicated to providing people with disabilities enrichment, empowerment, and employment opportunities. Through vocational training, community employment, day services, advocacy, arts and social recreation, these people are able to find new friends, realize future career paths, seek independence and community integration, and unleash creative passions.

Opportunity Village believes people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families should have choices in where and how they are served. **DAY HABILITATION:** Day habilitation services include enrichment opportunities following our "Live-Learn-Grow" curriculum which focuses on activities of daily living, communication, neighborhood exploration, and community volunteerism. There is full-time nursing staff on-site to support the various health needs of participants.



TRANSITION SERVICES: The Job Discovery Program (JDP) is operated jointly by Opportunity Village and the Clark County School District (CCSD) and is targeted toward students with disabilities who have a goal of being competitively employed.



PRE-VOCATIONAL: Pre-vocational services provide work-readiness training through various activities in a wide array of fields in communit-based job training, on the job simulation with the goal of competitive employment.





VOCATIONAL: Vocational services include assessments, job placement, employee advocacy, job coaching, follow-along support, and employment retention and monitoring. The goal is to provide long-term support for integrated employment.

YOUTH SERVICES: For the last several years, Opportunity Village has collaborated with the Clark County School District (CCSD) to offer the Very Important Arts (VIA) Program. This program was designed to give children, ages 3-22 with disabilities, opportunities for expression through art, dance, and more. Opportunity Village also started offering Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services to children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).



RESIDENTIAL: Betty's Village is a residential community owned by Opportunity Village. The community opened its doors in June 2021, was designed for people with disabilities in mind, but welcomes all. If a resident requires support services, they will be able to coordinate those independently or through Desert Regional Center.
