

Sick Leave Pool Enrollment

Open Enrollment Begins

May 1st through May 31st

The operation of the sick leave pool is dependent upon sick leave donations from licensed employees. Though you only need to donate once to enroll in the pool, educators may choose to donate up to one sick leave day each enrollment period. Currently, the pool is critically low on donated days. Even if you are already enrolled in the sick leave pool, please consider an additional donation to help sustain this benefit for those in critical need.

How does the Sick Leave Pool work?

- 1) Enrollment in the Sick Leave Pool is voluntary and available to all licensed employees.
- 2) The open enrollment and additional donation periods are September 1-30 and May 1-31 of each school year.
- 3) Enrollment and donation is open to any licensed educator who has accrued six (6) days of unused sick days.
- 4) One (1) sick leave day is deducted from each educator who joins or donates to the pool.
- 5) Lifetime usage of the pool is limited to 100 days maximum per person; immediate family members are not covered under this provision.
