ABOUT COHORT

The year long cohort prepares teachers for National Board certification and includes preparation for writing about teaching strategies, learning and effection, formative and summative assessments, safe engaging learning environment, differentiation techniques, videotaping your practice, information on NB Standards, the Architecture of Accomplished Teaching, the 5 Core Propositions and the scoring process.

COHORT REGISTRATION

A trained National Board Certified Teacher (NBCT) facilitator virtually coaches a cohort of candidates through the writing and development of each component. Candidate Support fees are \$275 for CCEA members and \$350 for non-members.

Cohort Registration will be August 15-26, 2022 with payment due to CCEA by September 26, 2022.

Each cohort receives twenty-four (24) hours of virtual professional development. The 24 hours consists of 20 hours of virtual session and 4 hours of content area collaboration.

Each cohort will have networking and collaboration with other candidates including Maintenance of Certification (MOC).



CERTIFICATION TIMELINE

Completing National Board Certification may take anywhere from one to five years, depending on the approach you take. The CCEA Cohort is yearly to guide you through the National Board process at whatever stage you are at..
