Admission Requirements*

To be considered for acceptance into the Master of Education program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Obtained a baccalaureate degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution of higher education prior to matriculation
- Earned a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.75 or higher
- Two letters of recommendation including one from a supervisor
- Personal statement
- Background check (waived for licensed teachers)
- Interview (waived for licensed teachers)
- Resume encouraged
