

## Clark County - LINCspring Cycle Rubric

As part of the Clark County salary advancement CUs, LINCspring cycles are reviewed before certificates are awarded. Below are the expectations for the work in LINCspring. Each section is carefully reviewed for high quality, complete responses.

Please review your work to make sure it meets LINC's criteria before submitting your request for a certificate. If any portion of the cycle you submit requires review, you will receive an email from "Lia from LINCspring" with information about what needs to be reviewed and resubmitted.

Criteria	Evidence
<b>Time Period Completion</b>	
	<p>To earn credit for two hours, each section should include high quality, complete responses (i.e. open ended questions are detailed and show thoughtful consideration and the Tinker shows a plan for implementation and/or clear understanding of the instructional strategy).</p> <p>In addition, sufficient time must pass (indicated by platform timestamps) between Reflect and Grow for actual implementation to occur.</p>
<b>Spark Completion</b>	
	The Spark video was watched all the way through and shows as complete in LINCspring.
<b>Reflect Completion</b>	
	All questions must be complete. Reflect section submissions include detailed, thoughtful and meaningful responses to the open ended questions that indicate your initial thinking on how you will implement that cycle's skill or strategy.
<b>Tinker Completion</b>	
	The Tinker section submission should clearly demonstrate that the cycle strategy was developed and/or implemented with students. This is the area of the cycle where you will spend most of your time developing a thorough action plan to implement.
<b>Grow Completion</b>	
	All questions must be complete. Reflections demonstrate that ideas were tested through the tinker implementation and show a level of reflection that connects learnings to next steps.
